Instructions for Out-patient Sedation and General Anaesthesia

Before Treatment

- 1** No food or drink for six hours or more preceding surgery with the exception of plain water in small amounts which may be taken up to two hours prior to surgery.
 - 2** No tight clothing should be worn and it should be possible to draw sleeves up past the elbow. Contact lenses must be removed (general anaesthesia only).
 - 3** Should you develop a cold, sore throat, influenza or any other illness, please telephone the surgery for assessment of the problem.
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After Treatment

- 1 A responsible adult must accompany the patient home. Travel by public transport is not acceptable.
- 2 Do not drive any vehicle or operate any machinery until the following day.
- 3 Do not undertake important business or personal matters until the following day.
- 4 Alcohol should not be consumed for at least 24 hours after the procedure.
- 5 In the event of any post operative complication, please contact the surgery during business hours. After hours, your dentist can be contacted through their personal listing in the white pages.
